## PHILANTHROPY SPOTLIGHT: THRIVE PENINSULA, INC.

Their website states: “Everyday, thousands of Virginia Peninsula residents endure financial hardship – struggling to survive. We are THRIVE, and we’re helping people.”

THRIVE Peninsula, Inc., or THRIVE for short, is a 501(c)(3) provides food, funds, and financial education to those in need in partnership with 65 Peninsula Churches. Financial assistance is used to fight homelessness and utility shut off. Families in need usually learn about THRIVE through area churches, the Housing Crisis Hotline and United Way.

After investigating current balances of bills due to ensure that any funds given will prevent eviction or utility shut off, THRIVE offers the financial assistance. THRIVE further encourages the financial stability of the family in need by providing financial education by mapping out a tailored household budget for the family.

THRIVE serves Newport News, York County and Hampton residents with their services. Last year they were only able to answer 32% of requests due to funding limitations.

Aside from the Churches, THRIVE partners with other civic and school groups, such as Woodside High School, Menchville High School, Warwick River Mennonite School, Woman’s Club of Newport News, Elks,

Kiwanis, Veteran Family Services and Social Services, just to name a few. They also partner with private businesses such as TowneBank, Lifeway, Two Men & a Truck and Beavers Law Firm, P.C. In partnering with the Churches, civic groups, and private businesses, THRIVE aims to avoid duplicating resources and to ensure the monies spent stay within our community.
